



## **ELIT call for application**

Dear colleagues!

I'd like to ask for your help in distributing the call for applications within project ELIT: The Empirical study of Literature Training Network, where FELA is one of the partner organisations. We have started this project just couple of weeks ago and our first (but crucial) task is to enroll 10 excellent early stage researchers that will take part in double/joint doctoral programs at our universities and in training program in the field of empirical research in reading literature we will prepare for them.

Deadline to submit applications is June 15th, 2020. Program starts next academic year (October 2020) and will last 3 years (the program will be completed by awarding double/joint doctoral degree). Our target group are individuals who completed Master study within study fields relevant for the study of reading and are interested in doctoral study. The eligibility criteria for the program, description and requirements for individual positions are part of the call and are detailed and very specific. (see our website)

- ESR9: Shared literary reading and mental well-being in the digital age (University of Stavanger, Norway)
- ESR10: Reading with digital tools in early childhood classroom settings (Tnava University, Slovakia)
